Injury's arising from being shot	All members of the group	 All sessions to be run according to rules and procedures set in the session notes. All sessions to be run according to published best practice as set by the NSRA Appropriate length air arms should be used. Appropriate ammunition should be used 1.77 Wadcutters. Range must be secured prior to session starting. Spectators to stay in safe waiting area. 	30/11/2020
Equipment Failure i.e. target board falling off.	Participants, instructors and intruders.	 Pre-session checks must be carried out as detailed in the session notes. Rear walls to be checked for holes or gaps prior to session. Lights on the top beam. 	
Hazards arising from the actions of group members i.e. Overcrowding and Disorderly behaviour.	Everyone involved with the session.	 Group Leader in attendance. Max group size 10. Instructor to be aware of group members aiming dangerously high of the targets. If overcrowding of the area occurs refer to EAP overcrowding. If the behaviour of the group becomes disorderly refer to EAP disorderly behaviour. 	
Hazards arising from the actions of the Instructor(s)	Participant's instructors and spectators.	 Instructors must pass in-house training and assessment by a NSRA Leader or higher before being allowed to run a session. Check to see if instructors need to be NSRA qualified rather than "in-house". 	
Risk or ricochet	All members	Only shoot at designated targets. All present in range to wear goggles at all times during session.
